INTRODUCTION. Atrial flutter is an abnormal cardiac rhythm characterized by rapid, regular atrial depolarizations at a characteristic rate of approximately 300 beats/min and a regular ventricular rate of about 150 beats/min in patients not taking atrioventricular (AV) nodal blockers.

Spencer The way that I understand it is this: Atrial flutter ablation is fairly simple in that it is normally only in the right atria. They come up from your groin and into your right atria. AFIB is normally in your left atria although it could be both. They go into your right atria as before and then make a hole and go thru to your left atria.

What's the Difference - AFlutter vs AFib Ablation

Ablation usually uses very hot or very cold temperatures at the tip of a catheter inserted into the heart to kill tissue. This procedure completely stops conduction from the atria to the ventricles and slows the ventricular rate. However, a permanent artificial pacemaker is required to activate the ventricles afterward.

Methods Patients with typical right atrial flutter or AF were prospectively enrolled in a single-arm study at 3 centers. Patients with atrial flutter underwent cavotricuspid isthmus (CTI) ablation.
