In manual shifting, a common tip is to shift up when within 1,000 rpm of the red line on the tachometer. However, this is no replacement for the rpm guide listed in the user manual.

Press the clutch all the way to the floor board with your left foot (the gear shifter must be in the neutral position). Turn the ignition key. If you are certain that the car is in neutral, you can remove your foot from the clutch. Ensure that the parking or emergency brake is not in use.

Implement the speed shift technique for your manual transmission by revving your engine before your launch from 2000 to 3500 rpm, depending upon the low-end torque of your vehicle (the more torque you have, the less you will need to rev your engine). Remember that the less you spin your tires, the quicker your launch will be.

1) Use the Clutch Pedal Between Shifts If you want your gear shifting to be as smooth as possible, then you need to use the clutch pedal between shifts. On the floor, you will see three pedals to choose from. The left pedal is the clutch pedal, the middle pedal is the brake pedal, and the right pedal is the gas pedal.

Shift to the gear before the one you are on. For our example we are shifting from 3rd gear to 2nd. You have to let go of the gas and press down in the clutch the whole time you are shifting. Once you have the gear you want give it gas and let go of the clutch simultaneously.

Calculate the best RPM for shifting using gear ratios and torque curve. The next highest gear ratio divided by the current gear ratio provides you with an optimal time to shift. Check the car's manual for recommend guidelines. The optimal RPM level changes depending on the type of car you drive.

Manual Transmission Components Clutch Lever - Located behind the left hand grip, the clutch lever controls the engagement of the clutch plates within the transmission. Foot Shifter - Located next to your left foot. Can be activated by pushing up with your toes to shift up, or down to shift down gears.
