Piano Concerto # 20 in d minor, K. 466 is the most historically popular and influential among his keyboard concertos. In this appraisal, we review the history of the genre, the reasons for the importance of the 20th concerto and Mozart's own style of playing, and then provide a selective survey of some historically important recordings, concluding with some sources for further information.

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Mozart K 466 Analysis Among Mozart's piano works, none are explicitly written with a part for a pedal-board. However, according to Leopold's report, at the first performance of Piano Concerto No. 20 in D Minor (K. 466), Mozart, who was the soloist and conductor, used his own piano, equipped with a pedal-board. 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The Piano Concerto No. 26 in D major, K. 537, was written by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart and completed on 24 February 1788. It is generally known as the Coronation Concerto.. The concerto is scored for solo piano, one flute, 2 oboes, 2 bassoons, 2 horns, 2 trumpets, timpano (in D, A), and strings.

Mozart K 466 Analysisishave structured and scored K. 466 (and much of his other work) had he lived a generation or two later – not in the classical era which he epitomized, but rather in the heart of the Romantic era which he anticipated and enabled in so many ways, and never as much as with his 20th piano concerto.
