Marriage is almost universal in Nepal. Data from the Chitwan study area show that in 1996, 98.3 % of men and 99.6 % of women between 30 and 34 years old were married. Ages at marriage are relatively low but have

been rising in the past few decades. The mean age at marriage between 1990 and 1996 was 17.6 for women and 21.9 for men (Yabiku 2005).
