Most manual transmission issues originate not with the transmission itself, but from related components like the clutch assembly, linkage, or driveline: the components that transmit turning power from the transmission to the wheels.

### Diagnosing Symptoms of a Bad Manual Transmission ...

Try to feel difference in force needed to push. Somewhere in middle of the way (usualy 1/3 of the way), you should feel something like small "step", like small change in force needed. After this point force is again the same as before. Now, try slowly to release pedal all the way up.
